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### Key terms:

- **Reception/EYFS:** Bees, Caterpillars & Ladybirds Classes
- **Quiet session:** Some parents/carers are invited to the 'quiet session' for our nativities, sports day and summer concert. These provide the families with an opportunity to see their child participate in the event with their class, but in a less overwhelming environment. Class teachers will invite families that they think would benefit from attending this session.
- **TLC:** Termly Learning Conferences. You and your child will have a 10-minute appointment in the hall with your child's class teacher/s to discuss their learning and progress. You will be able to book your appointment yourself and will be able to choose from an evening appointment after school on one day, or an appointment during the day on another day.
- **Learning Celebration:** parents/carers are invited into your child's classroom from 2.30pm to celebrate their learning with them. You may look at their exercise books, the class floor book and the classroom environment. It is an opportunity to see their learning and celebrate this with them.
