Outing to Penenden Heath - Wednesday 2<sup>nd</sup> October

To extend our learning in Year 1, we will be walking with the children to Penenden Heath on Wednesday 2<sup>nd</sup> October. The children will be focusing on local Geography by familiarising themselves with amenities in their community including the post office, park and tennis courts. We will also take the opportunity to make observations on trees and plants linking with our Science curriculum.

Lunch arrangements will be as normal. The children will walk to the Heath along a route which will have been risk assessed, and they will be escorted by sufficient adults to ensure their safety. The children will wear their normal school uniform and will need sensible shoes for walking in, and a waterproof coat.

We do not need to ask you to complete a permission slip, as this type of local outing is already covered by the General Signature Sheet which you signed when your child started at St Paul's.
