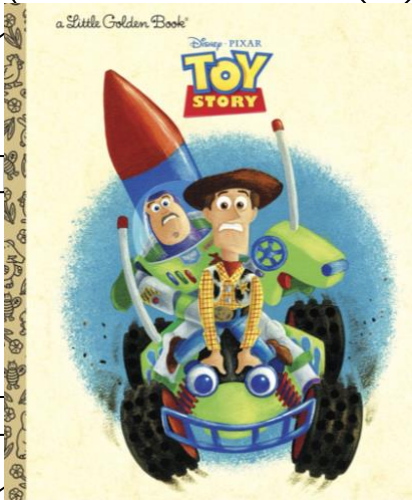

Why do we play with different toys as we get older?



English

- I can use a capital letter for names and for 'I'

- I can write two or three sentences about the same topic.

- I can write some lower case letters the way I have been shown.

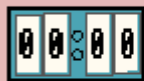

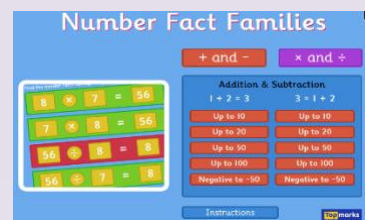


Can you name the different parts of our body? Can you put the body back together? Play the 3 games to test your knowledge:
