Pupil Premium funding: £71,100

Provision:

- A special education needs team to support teachers and Teaching Assistants in school to ensure, where possible, all children's needs are met in class and ensure that provision is well coordinated and effective support is given
- A Pastoral TA to support children in small groups and 1:1 and nurture pupils' emotional well being
- An Intervention TA to provide precision monitoring support in Literacy and Maths
- 2 Play leaders to support behaviour and provide planned play opportunities at lunchtimes
- A full time Family liaison officer
- A part time English as an Additional Language teacher
- Release time for the Deputy Headteacher to impact on raising standards for vulnerable pupils through supporting teaching and learning in school
- Financial assistance for attending school trips and extra-curricular activities
- School uniform
- Speech and language link assessments
- Resources to support transition of new starters and Service children, e.g. passports, initial assessments
- Continued professional development opportunities/courses to ensure teachers provide quality first teaching
- A 1:1 support assistant for a vulnerable pupil
